Thank you for inquiring about our Internship Program in Clinical Child Psychology. Morrison Child & Family Services participate in the APPIC Internship Matching Program. As you will see described in the brochure our child and family out patient services are quite extensive and multiple sites are involved. The APPIC match number for our program is 5242.

A complete application consists of the following:

- APPIC Application for Psychology Internship (AAPI), including all of its parts; Practicum Documentation Form; Professional Conduct Form; Verification of Internship Eligibility; Adult & Child Test Administration
- Graduate School Transcripts
- Three Letters of Recommendation
- Vita
- Copy of a Child Evaluation you conducted (edited for confidentiality)

The deadline for receipt of all application materials will be Tuesday, December 1, 2009.

Morrison Child and Family Services will host an **Open House** the afternoon of **Thursday, January 14, 2010 from 1pm – 3pm.** **Applicants who continue to be under consideration will be provided details about this optional event, for which there is no need to RSVP.** Candidates who are unable to attend will *not* be adversely affected; alternate opportunities for an informal visit may be arranged on request. In the interest of fairness to those unable to travel for a personal visit, only telephone interviews will be conducted with finalists.

Out one-year, full-time internship begins **Monday, August, 16, 2010.** The current stipend is \$17,472.00/year. Other benefits are described in the Program Brochure.
